Through self-reflection activities, practical examples, and case studies, you will start your IDEA journey on the path to self-awareness and inclusion.

This course is designed to get everyone on the same page when it comes to diversity and inclusion. By leveraging the experience of participants through discussions and group activities, we explore our own dimensions of diversity and the benefits of creating a diverse and inclusive workplace.
